A big thank you to everyone who has taken time to contemplate the issues of the Minster Communities preparation phase. It has been heartening to see how much interest has been shown amongst church members.

Thank you for completing your 'dashboards'. These have helped greatly in understanding our own perceptions of St. Peter's and will inform future decision-making. Our combined responses have now been sent in to the diocese.

There will be more to discuss as the process of forming Communities begins.

We are hosting a meeting for the congregations of both St. Peter's and St. Paul's in church at 7pm, Tuesday, 10th September. Rev'd Steve Bailey will be talking about the Minster Communities process and its implications.

This will be an opportunity to learn about progress to date and ask questions about what it might mean for our churches. Please make every effort to attend.

The 'Forming' stage of the process for all churches in Area 3 of the diocese will begin with a Discernment Day on 28th September. Our meeting on the 10th will be your opportunity both to find out more and to contribute comment and opinion which we can take forward to the Discernment Day.
