Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. 2 Cor 9:7


GIVING TO ST PETER'S

All that happens at St Peter's is made possible by those who pray, serve, and give to the work of the church. We could not do it without you. Thank you so much!


