## **Minster Communities, December, 2024**

Phase 1 of our discernment is drawing to a close.

At our PCC meeting on 21st November, members discussed the proposed Area 3 map that has been on display in church. As a result, we decided that our feedback to the diocese should include a desire to keep our benefice churches together and for St. Peter's to continue working with St. John's.

We have also received representations from the Knighton churches for inclusion in a Minster Community with us.

There will be no further Minster Communities discussion until January when we move into Phase 2 of the discernment process. All MComms information has been removed from display in church until then.
