## **MINSTER COMMUNITIES, April, 2025 (2)**

There is now a new map of Area 3 churches (see church notice board), with the addition of five churches in NW Leicester. However, these five churches will probably form a MC of their own, so this won't affect us at St. Peter's. Another MC is very likely to be comprised of Holy Trinity and St. Christopher's (also possibly with Enderby). That leaves St. Peter's amongst the rest of the 'Orange' group.

Phase 2 (Forming) ends in August when the final groupings should be nearer definition.

Questions for us between now and then revolve around which parishes we might want to work with. I sense a strong desire to keep the Oadby and Great Glen Benefice together.

Which other parishes could we join with? As it stands, this is a large group. What are your thoughts about that? Should it remain as one group? Would you like to see us in a smaller group? If so, with whom?

I have posed similar questions in our last two newssheets, but have only had a few responses. I'd be really grateful for your thoughts.

It might be a good idea to visit other churches to get a feeling about them. If you do, please let me have some feedback.

Remember, without our responses, the decision will be made for us!
