

Notes from PCC Meeting, 26th June.

From Minutes agreed on 31st July:

At the PCC meeting held 26th June, we acknowledged our farewell to Revd Sami Lyndsey and thanked the St. John's team for their work with us during our partnership with them. We also addressed handover issues remaining in face of James Banks' resignation, as from August.

Successes noted included the parish trip to Lincoln and Linda's continuing work with local schools, the continuation of Choral Evensong and good attendance at Peter's Place, Little Fishes and the Thursday morning services.

Re. **Finances**, Adrian Lane will take over from Anne Dobson as Treasurer. We also need to consider a drive to raise our annual Parish Contribution for 2026 to the level of supporting a full stipend.

Patsy Riddick continued her drive to raise awareness of the need for **Safeguarding** training, re. the Code of Safer Working Practice.

Revd Steve Bailey was able to confirm that we are now in Area 4 of the **Minster Communities** process. This puts our existing Oadby and Gt. Glen Benefice together with churches from the Kibworth Benefice.

The PCC acknowledged that our **website** needs further work and offers of ideas and feedback were requested.

Full minutes will be published in church.

The PCC has since met on Thursday, 31st July and the next meeting will be on Thursday, 25th September.
