Minster Communities, Autumn, 2025

Background Information

In May, 2025, St. Peter's and the other churches in the Oadby, Great Glen Benefice were transferred from the Area 3 group of churches to Area 4. The PCC has since indicated to the diocese that it is happy to explore the subsequent proposal of forming a Minster Community by amalgamating the Oadby, Great Glen Benefice with the Kibworth Benefice.

During the Summer

- members of St. Peter's took part in an informal meeting at St.Cuthbert's with reps from churches of both benefices.
- Rev'd Steve Bailey held a well-attended 'Vision And Values' meeting at St. Peter's. During this meeting, members of our congregation were able to discuss our identity as a church and plan for the way forward (- meeting notes have been published).
- Standing Committee members of Benefice churches met with our Team Rector, Rev'd Steve Bailey.
- Members of all our potential Minster churches joined an on-line information and discussion session, with Beth Cluer, Senior Parish Transition Officer and Facilitation Lead for the Diocese. Beth clarified the next stages and outlined the anticipated timescale.

During the Autumn

Working groups are now being created, and will meet during this Autumn, to discuss how our churches now view the information and data regarding the focus areas previously addressed through our storyboarding in 2024 (- on display in church).
